5. A volunteer has been asked to lead a craft activity with the kids. You walk by and notice eight children waiting at a table with nothing to do while the volunteer searches for supplies. What would you do in this situation?



6. You are leading an activity with a group of children. The volunteer assigned to help you doesn't seem to be getting involved and is sitting off to the side not talking with any of the children. How would you handle this situation?

7. While students are having free time, you notice a volunteer roughhousing with children in a way that is not allowed in the program. What do you do?

8. You and another volunteer/chaperone had a misunderstanding with instructions, and got into an argument in front of the youth. How would you resolve the issue?
